To get started, you'll need a: Valid email address (you must have access to this) Valid phone number Stable internet connection Here's how to create an account: Visit Click "Register Now" and fill out the form with your details as they appear on your academic documents. During registration, you'll be asked for your name, email address, phone number, and gender. After registering, a one-time password (OTP) will be sent to both your email and phone. Check your email and SMS for the OTP and follow these steps: On the login page, choose "Login with Email" or "Login with Phone" and enter your email/phone number and OTP. You'll be prompted to create a new password. Follow the rules on password creation and click "Change Password" when done. ****Important:**** Your registration details are not editable, so make sure you provide correct information. To apply for a program: Visit Log in with your credentials You'll be presented with a list of running schemes. Choose your preferred scheme and click "Apply Now." Fill out the form as instructed, taking note of mandatory fields marked with an asterisk. When done, click "Save." You can always resume your application at any time. Log in to confirm and take note of this email ID, as it's where university info will be sent. Makerere University offers various study options at different career levels, from undergraduate to graduate and continuing education programs taught in English. Flexible study options include: - Evening Study for working-class individuals or those who meet admission requirements. - Distance learning/External study for those unable to attend regular classes due to reasons beyond their control. International students can apply through . Sign up using your full name, email, and mobile number. A password will be sent to both, which you'll need to change. Fill out the form, obtain a pay reference number (PRN), and pay the application fee of US\$75 or its equivalent in UGX via the payment procedure provided. Applicants with qualifications from languages other than English must have their documents translated into English by the School of Languages at Makerere University. Non-Ugandan applicants should refer to the Uganda National Examinations Board website for guidelines on equating academic credentials. Diploma or degree holders are required to attach certified copies of their academic records when submitting their online applications. Students from countries where English is not the primary language must demonstrate proficiency in English, and Makerere University's School of Languages can provide proficiency tests upon request. To be eligible for the Bachelor of Laws program at Makerere University, applicants must pass a pre-entry examination. International students are mandated to present insurance certificates from a recognized provider before admission. The academic year typically commences in August annually.
